

## **OANA General Meeting Minutes 05-20-2021**

Around 35 people turned out for the General Meeting to elect our new Board. We gathered outdoors under shelter at the back side of the Aycock Barn, in very breezy conditions. The meeting was called to order at 6:10 p.m., after all attendees had checked in to verify their eligibility to vote.
